### **Chapter 6**

- 6,1 For the Leader; with string-music; on the Sheminith. A Psalm of David.
- 6,2 O Lord, rebuke me not in Thine anger, neither chasten me in Thy wrath.
- 6,3 Be gracious unto me, O Lord, for I languish away; heal me, O Lord, for my bones are affrighted.
- 6,4 My soul also is sore affrighted; and Thou, O Lord, how long?
- 6,5 Return, O Lord, deliver my soul; save me for Thy mercy's sake.
- 6,6 For in death there is no remembrance of Thee; in the nether-world who will give Thee thanks?
- 6,7 I am weary with my groaning; every night make I my bed to swim; I melt away my couch with my tears.
- 6,8 Mine eye is dimmed because of vexation; it waxeth old because of all mine adversaries.
- 6,9 Depart from me, all ye workers of iniquity; for the Lord hath heard the voice of my weeping.
- 6,10 The Lord hath heard my supplication; the Lord receiveth my prayer.
- 6,11 All mine enemies shall be ashamed and sore affrighted; they shall turn back, they shall be ashamed suddenly.
