



Ketouvim (hagiographes) - Psaumes

Chapter 26

- 26,1 [A Psalm] of David. Judge me, O Lord, for I have walked in mine integrity, and I have trusted in the Lord without wavering.
- 26,2 Examine me, O Lord, and try me; test my reins and my heart.
- 26,3 For Thy mercy is before mine eyes; and I have walked in Thy truth.
- 26,4 I have not sat with men of falsehood; neither will I go in with dissemblers.
- 26,5 I hate the gathering of evil doers, and will not sit with the wicked.
- 26,6 I will wash my hands in innocency; so will I compass Thine altar, O Lord,
- 26,7 That I may make the voice of thanksgiving to be heard, and tell of all Thy wondrous works.
- 26,8 Lord, I love the habitation of Thy house, and the place where Thy glory dwelleth.
- 26,9 Gather not my soul with sinners, nor my life with men of blood;
- 26,10 In whose hands is craftiness, and their right hand is full of bribes.
- 26,11 But as for me, I will walk in mine integrity; redeem me, and be gracious unto me.
- 26,12 My foot standeth in an even place; in the congregations will I bless the Lord.
