

Ketouvim (hagiographes) - Psaumes

Chapter 30

- 30,1 A Psalm; a Song at the Dedication of the House; of David.
- 30,2 I will extol thee, O Lord, for Thou hast raised me up, and hast not suffered mine enemies to rejoice over me.
- 30,3 O Lord my God, I cried unto Thee, and Thou didst heal me;
- 30,4 O Lord, Thou broughtest up my soul from the nether-world; Thou didst keep me alive, that I should not go down to the pit.
- 30,5 Sing praise unto the Lord, O ye His godly ones, and give thanks to His holy name.
- 30,6 For His anger is but for a moment, His favour is for a life-time; weeping may tarry for the night, but joy cometh in the morning.
- 30,7 Now I had said in my security: 'I shall never be moved.'
- 30,8 Thou hadst established, O Lord, in Thy favour my mountain as a stronghold-- Thou didst hide Thy face; I was affrighted.
- 30,9 Unto Thee, O Lord, did I call, and unto the Lord I made supplication:
- 30,10 'What profit is there in my blood, when I go down to the pit? Shall the dust praise Thee? shall it declare Thy truth?
- 30,11 Hear, O Lord, and be gracious unto me; Lord, be Thou my helper.'
- 30,12 Thou didst turn for me my mourning into dancing; Thou didst loose my sackcloth, and gird me with gladness;
- 30,13 So that my glory may sing praise to Thee, and not be silent; O Lord my God, I will give thanks unto Thee for ever.
