## **Chapter 52**

- 52,1 For the Leader. Maschil of David;
- 52,2 when Doeg the Edomite came and told Saul, and said unto him: 'David is come to the house of Ahimelech.'
- 52,3 Why boastest thou thyself of evil, O mighty man? The mercy of God endureth continually.
- 52,4 Thy tongue deviseth destruction; like a sharp razor, working deceitfully.
- 52,5 Thou lovest evil more than good; falsehood rather than speaking righteousness. Selah
- 52,6 Thou lovest all devouring words, the deceitful tongue.
- 52,7 God will likewise break thee for ever, He will take thee up, and pluck thee out of thy tent, and root thee out of the land of the living. Selah
- 52,8 The righteous also shall see, and fear, and shall laugh at him:
- 52,9 'Lo, this is the man that made not God his stronghold; but trusted in the abundance of his riches, and strengthened himself in his wickedness.'
- 52,10 But as for me, I am like a leafy olive-tree in the house of God; I trust in the mercy of God for ever and ever.
- 52,11 I will give Thee thanks for ever, because Thou hast done it; and I will wait for Thy name, for it is good, in the presence of Thy saints.
