Chapter 119

- 119,1 ALEPH. Happy are they that are upright in the way, who walk in the law of the Lord.
- 119,2 Happy are they that keep His testimonies, that seek Him with the whole heart.
- 119,3 Yea, they do no unrighteousness; they walk in His ways.
- 119,4 Thou hast ordained Thy precepts, that we should observe them diligently.
- 119,5 Oh that my ways were directed to observe Thy statutes!
- 119,6 Then should I not be ashamed, when I have regard unto all Thy commandments.
- 119,7 I will give thanks unto Thee with uprightness of heart, when I learn Thy righteous ordinances.
- 119,8 I will observe Thy statutes; O forsake me not utterly.
- 119,9 BETH. Wherewithal shall a young man keep his way pure? By taking heed thereto according to Thy word.
- 119,10 With my whole heart have I sought Thee; O let me not err from Thy commandments.
- 119,11 Thy word have I laid up in my heart, that I might not sin against Thee.
- 119,12 Blessed art Thou, O Lord; teach me Thy statutes.
- 119,13 With my lips have I told all the ordinances of Thy mouth.
- 119,14 I have rejoiced in the way of Thy testimonies, as much as in all riches.
- 119,15 I will meditate in Thy precepts, and have respect unto Thy ways.
- 119,16 I will delight myself in Thy statutes; I will not forget Thy word.
- 119,17 GIMEL. Deal bountifully with Thy servant that I may live, and I will observe Thy word.
- 119,18 Open Thou mine eyes, that I may behold wondrous things out of Thy law.
- 119,19 I am a sojourner in the earth; hide not Thy commandments from me.
- 119,20 My soul breaketh for the longing that it hath unto Thine ordinances at all times.
- 119,21 Thou hast rebuked the proud that are cursed, that do err from Thy commandments.
- 119,22 Take away from me reproach and contempt; for I have kept Thy testimonies.
- 119,23 Even though princes sit and talk against me, thy servant doth meditate in Thy statutes.
- 119,24 Yea, Thy testimonies are my delight, they are my counsellors.
- 119,25 DALETH. My soul cleaveth unto the dust; guicken Thou me according to Thy word.
- 119,26 I told of my ways, and Thou didst answer me; teach me Thy statutes.
- 119,27 Make me to understand the way of Thy precepts, that I may talk of Thy wondrous works.
- 119,28 My soul melteth away for heaviness; sustain me according unto Thy word.
- 119,29 Remove from me the way of falsehood; and grant me Thy law graciously.
- 119,30 I have chosen the way of faithfulness; Thine ordinances have I set [before me].
- 119,31 I cleave unto Thy testimonies; O Lord, put me not to shame.
- 119,32 I will run the way of Thy commandments, for Thou dost enlarge my heart.
- 119,33 HE. Teach me, O Lord, the way of Thy statutes; and I will keep it at every step.



- 119,34 Give me understanding, that I keep Thy law and observe it with my whole heart.
- 119,35 Make me to tread in the path of Thy commandments; for therein do I delight.
- 119,36 Incline my heart unto Thy testimonies, and not to covetousness.
- 119,37 Turn away mine eyes from beholding vanity, and quicken me in Thy ways.
- 119,38 Confirm Thy word unto Thy servant, which pertaineth unto the fear of Thee.
- 119,39 Turn away my reproach which I dread; for Thine ordinances are good.
- 119,40 Behold, I have longed after Thy precepts; quicken me in Thy righteousness.
- 119,41 VAV. Let Thy mercies also come unto me, O Lord, even Thy salvation, according to Thy word;
- 119,42 That I may have an answer for him that taunteth me; for I trust in Thy word.
- 119,43 And take not the word of truth utterly out of my mouth; for I hope in Thine ordinances;
- 119,44 So shall I observe Thy law continually for ever and ever;
- 119,45 And I will walk at ease, for I have sought Thy precepts;
- 119,46 I will also speak of Thy testimonies before kings, and will not be ashamed.
- 119,47 And I will delight myself in Thy commandments, which I have loved.
- 119,48 I will lift up my hands also unto Thy commandments, which I have loved; and I will meditate in Thy statutes.
- 119,49 ZAIN. Remember the word unto Thy servant, because Thou hast made me to hope.
- 119,50 This is my comfort in my affliction, that Thy word hath guickened me.
- 119,51 The proud have had me greatly in derision; yet have I not turned aside from Thy law.
- 119,52 I have remembered Thine ordinances which are of old, O Lord, and have comforted myself.
- 119,53 Burning indignation hath taken hold upon me, because of the wicked that forsake Thy law.
- 119,54 Thy statutes have been my songs in the house of my pilgrimage.
- 119,55 I have remembered Thy name, O Lord, in the night, and have observed Thy law.
- 119,56 This I have had, that I have kept Thy precepts.
- 119,57 HETH. My portion is the Lord, I have said that I would observe Thy words.
- 119,58 I have entreated Thy favour with my whole heart; be gracious unto me according to Thy word.
- 119,59 I considered my ways, and turned my feet unto Thy testimonies.
- 119,60 I made haste, and delayed not, to observe Thy commandments.
- 119,61 The bands of the wicked have enclosed me; but I have not forgotten Thy law.
- 119,62 At midnight I will rise to give thanks unto Thee because of Thy righteous ordinances.
- 119,63 I am a companion of all them that fear Thee, and of them that observe Thy precepts.
- 119,64 The earth, O Lord, is full of Thy mercy; teach me Thy statutes.
- 119,65 TETH. Thou hast dealt well with Thy servant, O Lord, according unto Thy word.
- 119,66 Teach me good discernment and knowledge; for I have believed Thy commandments.
- 119,67 Before I was afflicted, I did err; but now I observe Thy word.
- 119,68 Thou art good, and doest good; teach me Thy statutes.
- 119,69 The proud have forged a lie against me; but I with my whole heart will keep Thy precepts.
- 119,70 Their heart is gross like fat; but I delight in Thy law.
- 119,71 It is good for me that I have been afflicted, in order that I might learn Thy statutes.
- 119,72 The law of Thy mouth is better unto me than thousands of gold and silver.
- 119,73 IOD. Thy hands have made me and fashioned me; give me understanding, that I may learn Thy commandments.



- 119,74 They that fear Thee shall see me and be glad, because I have hope in Thy word.
- 119,75 I know, O Lord, that Thy judgments are righteous, and that in faithfulness Thou hast afflicted me.
- 119,76 Let, I pray Thee, Thy lovingkindness be ready to comfort me, according to Thy promise unto Thy servant.
- 119,77 Let Thy tender mercies come unto me, that I may live; for Thy law is my delight.
- 119,78 Let the proud be put to shame, for they have distorted my cause with falsehood; but I will meditate in Thy precepts.
- 119,79 Let those that fear Thee return unto me, and they that know Thy testimonies.
- 119,80 Let my heart be undivided in Thy statutes, in order that I may not be put to shame.
- 119,81 CAPH. My soul pineth for Thy salvation; in Thy word do I hope.
- 119,82 Mine eyes fail for Thy word, saying: 'When wilt Thou comfort me?'
- 119,83 For I am become like a wine-skin in the smoke; yet do I not forget Thy statutes.
- 119,84 How many are the days of Thy servant? When wilt Thou execute judgment on them that persecute me?
- 119,85 The proud have digged pits for me, which is not according to Thy law.
- 119,86 All Thy commandments are faithful; they persecute me for nought; help Thou me.
- 119,87 They had almost consumed me upon earth; but as for me, I forsook not Thy precepts.
- 119,88 Quicken me after Thy lovingkindness, and I will observe the testimony of Thy mouth.
- 119,89 LAMED. For ever, O Lord, Thy word standeth fast in heaven.
- 119,90 Thy faithfulness is unto all generations; Thou hast established the earth, and it standeth.
- 119,91 They stand this day according to Thine ordinances; for all things are Thy servants.
- 119,92 Unless Thy law had been my delight, I should then have perished in mine affliction.
- 119,93 I will never forget Thy precepts; for with them Thou hast quickened me.
- 119,94 I am Thine, save me; for I have sought Thy precepts.
- 119,95 The wicked have waited for me to destroy me; but I will consider Thy testimonies.
- 119,96 I have seen an end to every purpose; but Thy commandment is exceeding broad.
- 119,97 MEM. O how love I Thy law! It is my meditation all the day.
- 119,98 Thy commandments make me wiser than mine enemies: for they are ever with me.
- 119,99 I have more understanding than all my teachers; for Thy testimonies are my meditation.
- 119,100 understand more than mine elders, because I have keep Thy precepts.
- 119,101l have refrained my feet from every evil way, in order that I might observe Thy word.
- 119,102 have not turned aside from Thine ordinances; for Thou hast instructed me.
- 119,103How sweet are Thy words unto my palate! yea, sweeter than honey to my mouth!
- 119,104From Thy precepts I get understanding; therefore I hate every false way.
- 119,105NUN. Thy word is a lamp unto my feet, and a light unto my path.
- 119,106 have sworn, and have confirmed it, to observe Thy righteous ordinances.
- 119,107l am afflicted very much; quicken me, O Lord, according unto Thy word.
- 119,108Accept, I beseech Thee, the freewill-offerings of my mouth, O Lord, and teach me Thine ordinances.
- 119,109My soul is continually in my hand; yet have I not forgotten Thy law.
- 119,110The wicked have laid a snare for me; yet went I not astray from Thy precepts.
- 119,111Thy testimonies have I taken as a heritage for ever; for they are the rejoicing of my heart.
- 119,112 have inclined my heart to perform Thy statutes, for ever, at every step.
- 119,113SAMECH. I hate them that are of a double mind; but Thy law do I love.



- 119,114Thou art my covert and my shield; in Thy word do I hope.
- 119,115Depart from me, ye evildoers; that I may keep the commandments of my God.
- 119,116Uphold me according unto Thy word, that I may live; and put me not to shame in my hope.
- 119,117Support Thou me, and I shall be saved; and I will occupy myself with Thy statutes continually.
- 119,118Thou hast made light of all them that err from Thy statutes; for their deceit is vain.
- 119,119Thou puttest away all the wicked of the earth like dross; therefore I love Thy testimonies.
- 119,120My flesh shuddereth for fear of Thee; and I am afraid of Thy judgments.
- 119,121AIN. I have done justice and righteousness; leave me not to mine oppressors.
- 119,122Be surety for Thy servant for good; let not the proud oppress me.
- 119,123Mine eyes fail for Thy salvation, and for Thy righteous word.
- 119,124Deal with Thy servant according unto Thy mercy, and teach me Thy statutes.
- 119,125 am Thy servant, give me understanding, that I may know Thy testimonies.
- 119,126t is time for the Lord to work; they have made void Thy law.
- 119,127Therefore I love Thy commandments above gold, yea, above fine gold.
- 119,128Therefore I esteem all [Thy] precepts concerning all things to be right; every false way I hate.
- 119,129PE. Thy testimonies are wonderful; therefore doth my soul keep them.
- 119,130The opening of Thy words giveth light; it giveth understanding unto the simple.
- 119,131l opened wide my mouth, and panted; for I longed for Thy commandments.
- 119,132Turn Thee towards me, and be gracious unto me, as is Thy wont to do unto those that love Thy name.
- 119,133Order my footsteps by Thy word; and let not any iniquity have dominion over me.
- 119,134Redeem me from the oppression of man, and I will observe Thy precepts.
- 119,135 Make Thy face to shine upon Thy servant; and teach me Thy statutes.
- 119,136Mine eyes run down with rivers of water, because they observe not Thy law.
- 119,137TZADE. Righteous art Thou, O Lord, and upright are Thy judgments.
- 119,138Thou hast commanded Thy testimonies in righteousness and exceeding faithfulness.
- 119,139My zeal hath undone me, because mine adversaries have forgotten Thy words.
- 119,140Thy word is tried to the uttermost, and Thy servant loveth it.
- 119,141 am small and despised; yet have I not forgotten Thy precepts.
- 119,142Thy righteousness is an everlasting righteousness, and Thy law is the truth.
- 119,143Trouble and anguish have overtaken me; yet Thy commandments are my delight.
- 119,144Thy testimonies are righteous for ever; give me understanding, and I shall live.
- 119,145KOPH. I have called with my whole heart; answer me, O Lord; I will keep Thy statutes.
- 119,146 have called Thee, save me, and I will observe Thy testimonies.
- 119,147 rose early at dawn, and cried; I hoped in Thy word.
- 119,148Mine eyes forestalled the night-watches, that I might meditate in Thy word.
- 119,149Hear my voice according unto Thy lovingkindness; quicken me, O Lord, as Thou art wont.
- 119,150They draw nigh that follow after wickedness; they are far from Thy law.
- 119,151Thou art nigh, O Lord; and all Thy commandments are truth.
- 119,1520f old have I known from Thy testimonies that Thou hast founded them for ever.
- 119,153RESH. O see mine affliction, and rescue me; for I do not forget Thy law.
- 119,154Plead Thou my cause, and redeem me; quicken me according to Thy word.



- 119,155Salvation is far from the wicked; for they seek not Thy statutes.
- 119,156Great are Thy compassions, O Lord; guicken me as Thou art wont.
- 119,157Many are my persecutors and mine adversaries; yet have I not turned aside from Thy testimonies.
- 119,158 beheld them that were faithless, and strove with them; because they observed not Thy word.
- 119,1590 see how I love Thy precepts; quicken me, O Lord, according to Thy lovingkindness.
- 119,160The beginning of Thy word is truth; and all Thy righteous ordinance endureth for ever.
- 119,161SHIN. Princes have persecuted me without a cause; but my heart standeth in awe of Thy words.
- 119,162 rejoice at Thy word, as one that findeth great spoil.
- 119,163 hate and abhor falsehood; Thy law do I love.
- 119,164Seven times a day do I praise Thee, because of Thy righteous ordinances.
- 119,165Great peace have they that love Thy law; and there is no stumbling for them.
- 119,166 have hoped for Thy salvation, O Lord, and have done Thy commandments.
- 119,167My soul hath observed Thy testimonies; and I love them exceedingly.
- 119,168 have observed Thy precepts and Thy testimonies; for all my ways are before Thee.
- 119,169TAU. Let my cry come near before Thee, O Lord; give me understanding according to Thy word.
- 119,170Let my supplication come before Thee; deliver me according to Thy word.
- 119,171Let my lips utter praise: because Thou teachest me Thy statutes.
- 119,172Let my tongue sing of Thy word; for all Thy commandments are righteousness.
- 119,173Let Thy hand be ready to help me; for I have chosen Thy precepts.
- 119,174 have longed for Thy salvation, O Lord; and Thy law is my delight.
- 119,175Let my soul live, and it shall praise Thee; and let Thine ordinances help me.
- 119,176 have gone astray like a lost sheep; seek Thy servant; for I have not forgotten Thy commandments.
