Chapter 132

- 132,1 A Song of Ascents. Lord, remember unto David all his affliction;
- 132,2 How he swore unto the Lord, and vowed unto the Mighty One of Jacob:
- 132,3 'Surely I will not come into the tent of my house, nor go up into the bed that is spread for me;
- 132,4 I will not give sleep to mine eyes, nor slumber to mine eyelids;
- 132,5 Until I find out a place for the Lord, a dwelling-place for the Mighty One of Jacob.'
- 132,6 Lo, we heard of it as being in Ephrath; we found it in the field of the wood.
- 132,7 Let us go into His dwelling-place; let us worship at His footstool.
- 132,8 Arise, O Lord, unto Thy resting-place; Thou, and the ark of Thy strength.
- 132,9 Let Thy priests be clothed with righteousness; and let Thy saints shout for joy.
- 132,10 For Thy servant David's sake turn not away the face of Thine anointed.
- 132,11 The Lord swore unto David in truth; He will not turn back from it: 'Of the fruit of thy body will I set upon thy throne.
- 132,12 If thy children keep My covenant and My testimony that I shall teach them, their children also for ever shall sit upon thy throne.'
- 132,13 For the Lord hath chosen Zion; He hath desired it for His habitation:
- 132,14 'This is My resting-place for ever; here will I dwell; for I have desired it.
- 132,15 I will abundantly bless her provision; I will give her needy bread in plenty.
- 132,16 Her priests also will I clothe with salvation; and her saints shall shout aloud for joy.
- 132,17 There will I make a horn to shoot up unto David, there have I ordered a lamp for Mine anointed.
- 132,18 His enemies will I clothe with shame; but upon himself shall his crown shine.'
