Chapter 138

- 138,1 [A Psalm] of David. I will give Thee thanks with my whole heart, in the presence of the mighty will I sing praises unto Thee.
- 138,2 I will bow down toward Thy holy temple, and give thanks unto Thy name for Thy mercy and for Thy truth; for Thou hast magnified Thy word above all Thy name.
- 138,3 In the day that I called, Thou didst answer me; Thou didst encourage me in my soul with strength.
- 138,4 All the kings of the earth shall give Thee thanks, O Lord, for they have heard the words of Thy mouth.
- 138,5 Yea, they shall sing of the ways of the Lord; for great is the glory of the Lord.
- 138,6 For though the Lord be high, yet regardeth He the lowly, and the haughty He knoweth from afar.
- 138,7 Though I walk in the midst of trouble, Thou quickenest me; Thou stretchest forth Thy hand against the wrath of mine enemies, and Thy right hand doth save me.
- 138,8 The Lord will accomplish that which concerneth me; Thy mercy, O Lord, endureth for ever; forsake not the work of Thine own hands.
