

Neviim (prophètes) - Ézéchiel

Chapter 15

- 15,1 And the word of the Lord came unto me, saying:
- 15,2 son of man, what is the vine-tree more than any tree, the vine branch which grew up among the trees of the forest?
- 15,3 Shall wood be taken thereof to make any work? or will men take a pin of it to hang any vessel thereon?
- Behold, it is cast into the fire for fuel; the fire hath devoured both the ends of it, and the midst of it is singed; is it profitable for any work?
- 15,5 Behold, when it was whole, it was meet for no work; how much less, when the fire hath devoured it, and it is singed, shall it yet be meet for any work?
- 15,6 Therefore thus saith the Lord God: As the vine-tree among the trees of the forest, which I have given to the fire for fuel, so do I give the inhabitants of Jerusalem.
- 15,7 And I will set My face against them; out of the fire are they come forth, and the fire shall devour them; and ye shall know that I am the Lord, when I set My face against them.
- 15,8 And I will make the land desolate, because they have acted treacherously, saith the Lord God.'
